

In terms of the updated trend of Africa's demographic performance, the average population growth rate between 1950 and 2015 is 2.3 percent per annum. It is 0.8 percent for Central Africa and 1.9 percent for West Africa. On the other hand, East Africa and Southern Africa experienced a negative growth rate (a decline of 0.1 percent and 0.3 percent, respectively) in the last 50 years. For South Africa, the current population growth rate is 1.6 percent per annum. It is the highest level of population growth among all countries in the region. It is followed by Zambia with 1.5 percent, Zimbabwe with 0.9 percent and Botswana with 0.6 percent. The sub-Saharan Africa's population in 1950 was 27 million people. By 2015, it was 1,022 million. In 1950, all of the sub-Saharan Africa's population lived in 15 countries, whereas in 2015, there were 44 countries with sub-Saharan Africa's population. According to the United Nations, the most populous country in the region is Nigeria, followed by Ethiopia and Ghana. The least populous is Burkina Faso with 13 million people. In 1950, the population of sub-Saharan Africa was distributed in the same way as in 2015, except that the east region was added to the West region. Cambodia in the 1990s saw its economy almost collapse, with the country's GDP declining from \$114 million to \$1.2 million. By 2015, it had recovered from that low point and seen a growth of 9.4 percent, according to the World Bank. Cambodia is Asia's second most populous country after India, with 23.5 million people. But Cambodia has an average annual population growth rate of 3.5 percent. While this is a negative number, Cambodia's population density is the highest in the world. As per 2011 statistics, Cambodia has 7,180 people per square kilometer. This is significantly higher than the world average of 2,741 people per square kilometer.
